Dear Parents and Guardians,

This letter is to advise you that St. Michael's College School was notified on November 11, 2021, that a Grade 12 student tested positive for COVID-19. The student is being cared for by his family and has been in contact with our school nurse.

The source of this exposure is external to the school. We are sharing this update out of an abundance of caution as we diligently work together to stop the spread of COVID-19.

All appropriate steps are being followed for the health, safety, and well-being of our community. Toronto Public Health (TPH) has been notified and they have confirmed that this is a non-exposure case. The student has not been at school since the exposure. Details of the investigation cannot be shared due to privacy considerations, however our diligence as a community has again mitigated further risk at this time.

We would like to remind all of our families that should your son develop any signs or symptoms of illness, it is imperative they remain home from school and monitor for any signs of COVID-19. This is especially important over the next 14 days.

Please contact the Attendance Office with a detailed message about why your son will be missing school. The School Nurse will follow up with families to advise on a safe return to school.

Thank you to all of our families for your continued adherence to our health and safety protocols.

In accordance with provincial requirements, this news will be posted to the COVID-19 advisory page on our school website.

On behalf of the SMCS community, our thoughts are with the ill student as we wish him a quick recovery.
